I refer to Petition 4179-24 (the Petition) tabled in the Legislative Assembly on 1 April 2025 regarding the Queensland Parliament's e-petition system.

The Petition is seeking the Parliamentary Service to undertake certain investigations in relation to the operation of the e-petition system, with these investigations possibly leading to changes to the system.

I note that the requirements for e-petitions are outlined in Chapter 21 of the Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Assembly (Standing Orders). The Committee of the Legislative Assembly (CLA) has responsibility for the oversight of the Standing Orders and the practices and procedures of the Legislative Assembly.

Under the *Parliamentary Service Act 1988*, responsibility for the Parliamentary Service rests with the Honourable Pat Weir MP, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, and yourself, as Clerk of the Parliament.

Accordingly, I ask that you bring the Petition to the attention of the Speaker for consideration as both of you deem appropriate.
