

Dear Mr Laurie *Neil*

I refer to petition numbers 1362-09 and 1395-10 lodged with the Legislative Assembly by Mr Peter Dowling MP, Member for Redlands, on 9 February and 11 March 2010, about the intersection of Giles Road with Cleveland-Redland Bay Road, Redland Bay.

The department is currently undertaking preliminary corridor planning works for the duplication of this section of Cleveland-Redland Bay Road. The proposal at this stage is to signalise the intersection when upgrading works are carried out. However, this is not expected to occur soon since planning works are still being undertaken and the proposed upgrade remains unfunded at this stage.

Please be assured the department will continue to monitor the safety performance of the intersection and review the eligibility for SRS funding on safety grounds and will continue planning for signalisation of the intersection as part of the Cleveland-Redland Bay Road upgrade planning works.
