Thank you for your letter regarding Petition No. 4061-24, received by the Queensland Legislative Assembly on 30 April 2024, regarding the TAFE Marine Centre of Excellence – Fast Track Construction of the already planned for Stage 2. I thank the petitioners for raising this matter with me.

The Miles Government is committed to training Queenslanders in the Gold Coast region. This is in stark contrast to the record of the former Newman Government, which closed the Ridgeway Avenue TAFE and was planning on closing three of the six campuses in the Gold Coast region as recommended by the Queensland Skills and Training Taskforce Final Report. Only the Miles Government is committed to a strong and growing TAFE.

The Miles Government is training one million Queenslanders under the *Good Jobs, Great Training:* Queensland Skills Strategy 2024 – 2028. We are investing \$370 million in TAFE and training and funding another 30,000 Free TAFE places. Through Free TAFE, including Free Apprenticeships, we are putting Queenslanders on the path to good quality, high paying jobs.

Since 2017, we have invested over \$60 million in TAFE Facilities in the Gold Coast region. This includes the \$11.8 million Coomera Marine Centre of Excellence at Coomera TAFE. Queenslanders training at this state of the art facility can obtain qualifications in Marine Craft Construction and Marine Mechanical Technologies through free apprenticeships.

The Department of Employment, Small Business and Training maintains a close relationship with TAFE Queensland to support training delivery needs in the Gold Coast region, as well as other regions across Queensland.
