Thank you for your letter dated 22 May 2009 regarding petition number 1237-09 received by the Queensland Legislative Assembly.

I note the petition requests that the prescribed allowable noise limits from licensed premises be reduced.

The current limits, as provided in the *Liquor Regulation 2002*, have been in place since 1986. The limits were established by qualified persons from the Environmental Protection Agency and are considered to be a suitable compromise between the rights of residents and those of the hospitality industry.

At this time the Queensland Government has no plans to change the current legislation.
