Dear Mr Laurie

I refer to your letter of 18 March 2020 relating to Petition 3282-20 received by the Queensland Legislative Assembly regarding the reclassification of silencers from Category R weapons to Category A weapons.

The Queensland Police Service (QPS) has advised that Category R represents the most restricted weapons under Queensland's weapons licensing framework and that this category includes silencers and other items "made or used, or capable of being used or intended to be used, for reducing the sound caused by discharging a firearm".

Silencers have remained Category R since the modern category system was implemented following sweeping reforms to Australia's gun laws after the Port Arthur tragedy in 1996. In practice, this limits their possession to licensed armourers who repair weapons for official Commonwealth Defence or Commonwealth and State policing purposes, or Queensland collectors who, with the appropriate storage and licence, can possess permanently deactivated silencers.

Queensland remains committed to the spirit of the National Firearms Agreement. Therefore, in the interests of safety, I can advise that there is no intention to remove silencers from Category R weapons at this time.
