I refer to a petition lodged with the Legislative Assembly by Mr Jack Dempsey MP, Member for Bundaberg on 22 April 2009 regarding the need for a Driver and Rider Training Centre in Bundaberg.

I am advised that there are a number of private companies providing qualified driver and rider training to Bundaberg residents. In regard to motorcycle rider training, the Department of Transport and Main Roads' accreditation scheme, Q-Ride, is a competency based training and assessment program which aims to ensure participants reach a demonstrated level of skill and proficiency as a motorcycle rider. Currently there are two Q-Ride accredited service providers located in Bundaberg; Burnett Motorcycle Rider Training and Lern Ezy.

The Queensland Government acknowledges the petitioners' desire for a Bundaberg based Driver Training Centre. While there are no current plans to establish a Bundaberg based Driver Training Centre, my department will continue to review the services it provides to ensure that safety, convenience and the value for the taxpayer dollar are maximised.
