2 Appropriation for 2010–2011

- (1) The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$70 245 000 from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial year starting 1 July 2010.

- (2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1)—
15
 - (a) is appropriated for the financial year for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service to be applied to its departmental services, administered items and equity adjustment as stated in the schedule; and

 - (b) includes amounts for departmental services, administered items and equity adjustment delivered by the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service in the financial year starting 1 July 2009 but for which it has not been paid in that financial year.

- (3) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) includes the amount already authorised by the *Appropriation (Parliament) Act 2009*, section 3, to be paid for the financial year starting 1 July 2010.
